

AIR FRANCE IN PERU

5 new weekly flights between Paris and Lima:



On the strength of Peru's economic dynamism and tourism appeal (Peru is the preferred destination of French customers in South America), on 21 June 2011, Air France started operating 5 weekly flights between the French and Peruvian capitals. Air France and KLM currently offer 12 weekly flights between Europe and Peru, making the Group the leading European carrier between Peru and Europe:

**5 weekly flights Paris - Charles de Gaulle - Lima by Air France,
and 7 weekly flights Amsterdam - Schiphol - Lima by KLM.**

The new Paris-Lima route will also increase the opportunities for transporting goods (exotic fruit and flowers, vegetables, textiles, etc.) between Peru and France. Air France and KLM offer weekly cargo hold capacity of up to 165 tonnes.

New Business and Premium Voyageur offer



Air France serves Lima by Boeing 777-200 with 309 seats, including 35 in Business, 24 in Premium Voyageur and 250 in Voyageur – Economy class.

The new Business service: on board Air France's Boeing 777-200 serving Lima, customers will be able to discover the new long-haul Business service comprising a more varied choice of cuisine, a host of new services throughout the trip and a new Business class seat offering enhanced comfort thanks to:

- a lie-flat seat-bed measuring over 2m in length and a new fixed foot-rest;
- simple and more practical controls;
- new storage space and a 15-inch (or 38-cm) wide screen in 16:9 format

With Premium Voyageur, Air France offers:

- a private space with a 48-cm wide seat that reclines to 123° in a fixed shell offering 40% additional space compared with Voyageur (Economy) class, with
- a faster and more convenient service at the airport with access to Business check-in counters, boarding at the customers' convenience and priority baggage delivery
- an additional baggage allowance on most destinations;

4,600 flight attendants speak Spanish



Air France employs a minimum of two Spanish speaking-cabin crew members on flights serving Latin America. In total, over 4,600 Air France cabin staff members speak Spanish.

Access to the powerful Air France, KLM and Skyteam network:

Flight times are particularly suited for connections, via Paris-Charles de Gaulle and Amsterdam-Schiphol, with the powerful Air France and KLM network (254 destinations) and SkyTeam alliance (898 destinations).

Focus on the Air France Foundation in Peru: children at the heart of our commitment



Since it was founded in 1992, the aim of the Air France Corporate Foundation is to support projects in favour of children and young people who are sick, disabled or living in poverty, in France and abroad.

Since 1992, 98 associative projects have received aid from the Foundation in Latin America, amounting to a budget of close to 2 million euros. This year, 16 new projects have been financed in favour of children who are sick or living in difficult conditions in Latin America. In Peru, the Air France Foundation has financed 13 projects including 4 in this year's programme:

CARE France: promoting intercultural education in school

POMPIERS SANS FRONTIERES: risk prevention training for young people

INTERNATIONAL EMERGENCY SERVICES: help with the integration of disadvantaged teenagers

TERRE DES HOMMES: providing care to children living in difficult conditions in Lima

A leading carrier in Latin America

As part of its service to Latin America, Air France and KLM serve 13 destinations out of Paris and Amsterdam and offer 125 weekly flights in 11 countries: Argentina (7 weekly flights), Brazil (35 weekly flights), Chile (6 weekly flights), Columbia (7 weekly flights), Ecuador (5 weekly flights Guayaquil/Quito), Guyana (7 weekly flights), Mexico (28 weekly flights), Panama (6 weekly flights), Peru (12 weekly flights), Surinam (5 weekly flights) and Venezuela (7 weekly flights).

- Air France serves 9 destinations: Mexico, Bogota, Caracas, Lima, Sao Paulo, Rio de Janeiro, Buenos Aires, Santiago de Chile and Cayenne
- KLM serves 7 destinations: Mexico, Panama, Guayaquil, Quito, Lima, Sao Paulo, Paramaribo and in the coming winter season, Buenos Aires and Rio de Janeiro
